GDPR is an European Union regulation that requires organizations that process personal data for any EU citizens to identify the lawful basis for processing and storing personal data and to comply with data protection regulations.

As a school, we collect personal data to enable us to provide education and associated functions. HOPAC is committed to ensuring personal information is dealt with correctly and securely and in accordance to relevant national and international laws.
